The scores reported on the following pages are from students who completed a course with HSLDA Online Academy during the 2018-19 academic year and took the corresponding College Board Advanced Placement[®] (AP[®]) exam in May 2019.

The great majority of these scores are taken from the College Board's AP[®] Subject Score Roster for Online Providers (2019). The Subject Score Roster displays scores for each exam taken by HSLDA Online Academy students who identified HSLDA Online Academy as their online provider when they took the exam. A handful of the scores were reported to us by individual students.

Advanced Placement[®] exams are scored on a scale of 1 to 5, indicating whether the student is qualified in the exam's subject and recommended to receive college credit or advanced placement.

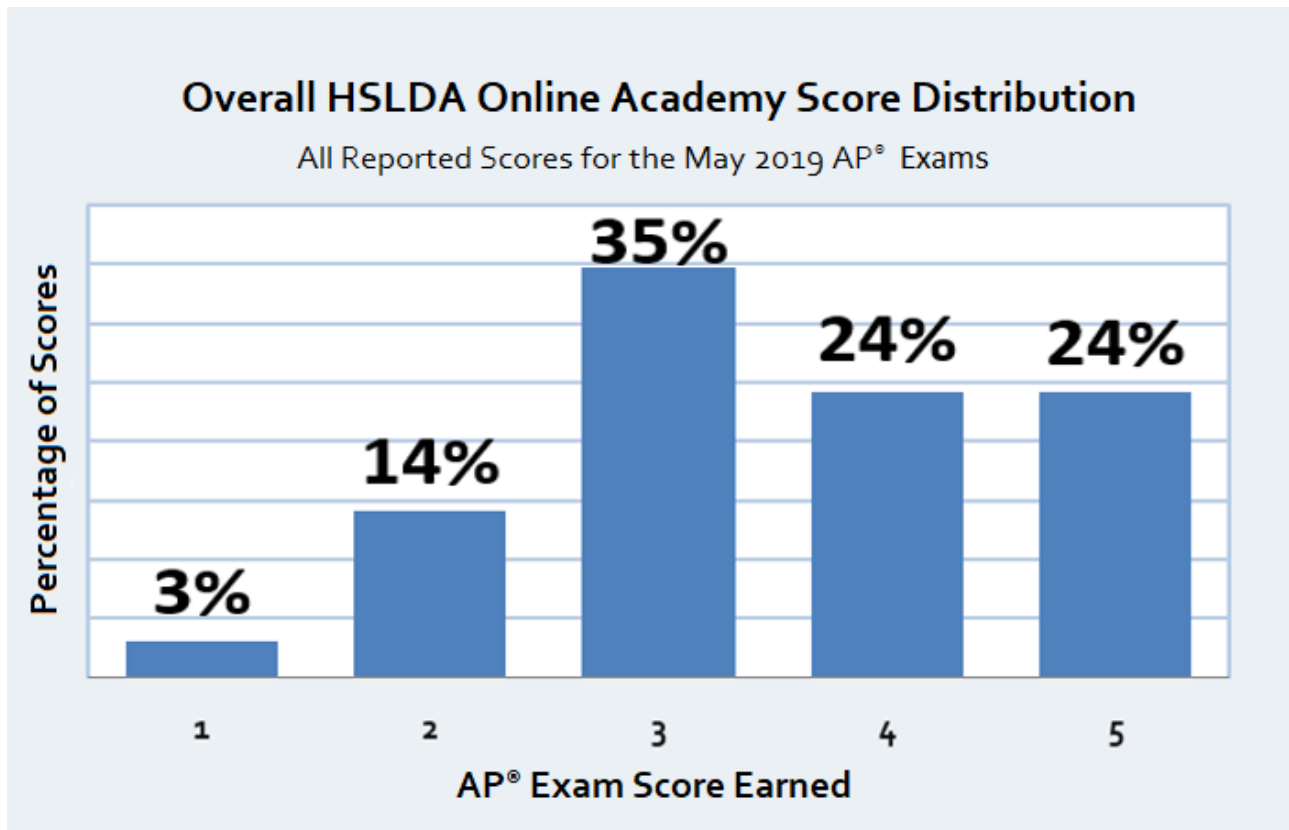

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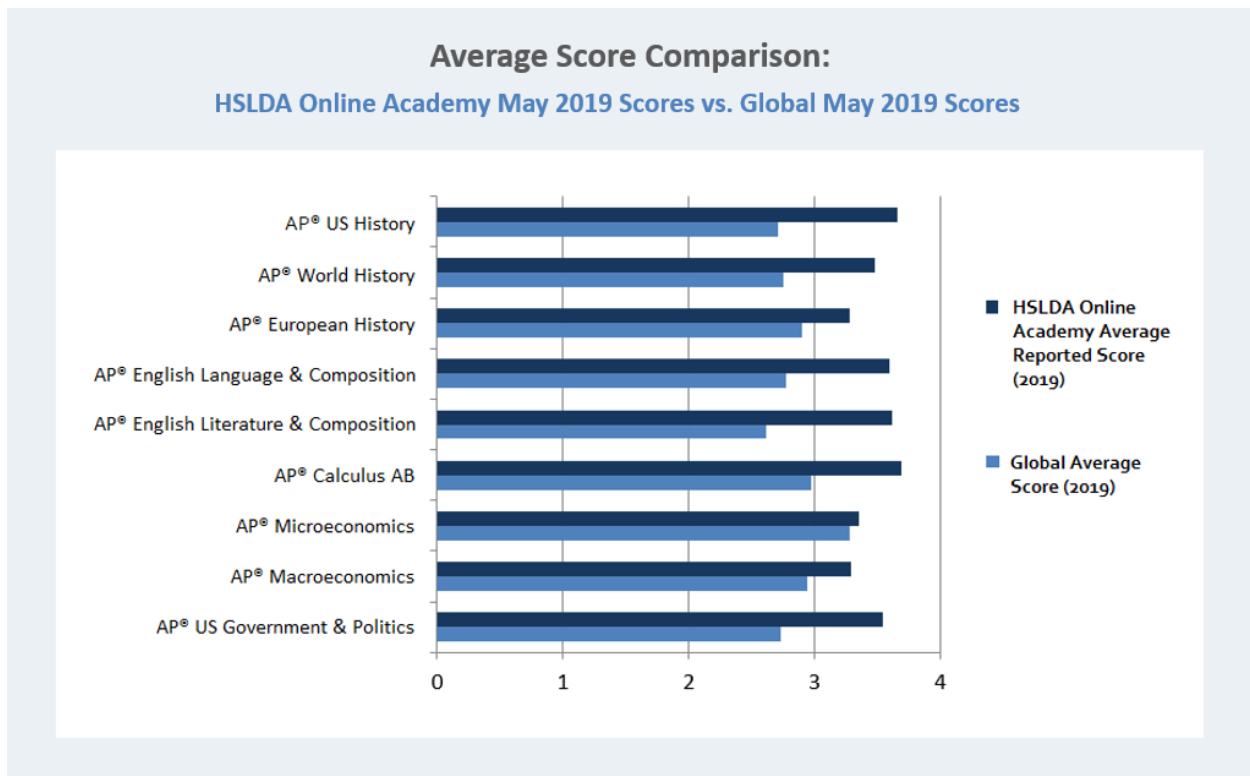
