BENEFITS OF TAKING CCU DUAL CREDIT COURSES

- Higher GPA in college
- Affordable college credit that transfers nationwide
- Prepares you for rigors of college courses
- Enter college with general education courses out of the way
- Shortens the time required to complete an undergraduate degree, allowing for the option of pursuing an additional major
- Students stay at their school, taught by their teachers using the high school's college-level curriculum
- A \$1,250/year (or \$5,000 over four years) scholarship for CCU dual credit students who choose to attend Colorado Christian University

CCU is accredited by The Higher Learning Commission of the North Central Association of Colleges and Schools.

REGISTRATION STEPS

1. Talk to your high school about their CCU dual credit courses.
2. Contact colleges or universities of interest in order to determine how CCU dual credit course credits will transfer.
3. Register for the course(s) with CCU at secure.ccu.edu/dualcredits.
4. Pay the course fee at the time of registration (If payment is made to your high school, payment will not be required for CCU course registration).
5. You will receive a payment confirmation email, a welcome email, and an email detailing how to register for WebAdvisor. WebAdvisor gives students access to CCU's online library resources and the ability to print unofficial transcripts.

SIGNING UP FOR WEBADVISOR

WebAdvisor gives dual credit students the ability to access CCU's online library database and print unofficial transcripts.

1. Students must set up a Digital Services Account (DSA) with CCU by completing the DSA application located at:
<https://apps.ccu.edu/DigitalServicesAccount/>
2. Have your CCU student ID number and social security number (SSN) handy.
3. International students may leave the SSN field blank.
4. Indicate your student type as DUAL CREDIT.
5. Set up your email address.
6. Your student ID is your user ID and you will create a password.

ORDERING TRANSCRIPTS AND TRANSFERABILITY OF CCU DUAL CREDITS

You can order a transcript through CCU's online ordering system at: ccu.edu/transcript. When placing your order, please indicate that you wish to have your transcript held until current semester grades are posted.

Because CCU is an accredited university, CCU dual credits transfer nationwide.

Students are encouraged to contact institutions of interest in order to determine how credits will transfer, as institutions vary on how they accept both AP and dual credits. CCU does not offer refunds for credits that do not transfer to institutions.
