About AP® Exam Scoring

Advanced Placement[®] exams are scored on a scale of 1 to 5, indicating whether the student is qualified in the exam's subject and recommended to receive college credit or advanced placement.

- 5 Extremely well qualified
- 4 Well qualified
- 3 Qualified
- 2 Possibly qualified
- 1 No recommendation

The AP® credit policy of each college or university determines the credit value of a particular score at that college or university (see https://apstudent.collegeboard.org/creditandplacement). Typically, a score of 3 or higher is considered a passing score.




