Advanced Placement[®] exams are scored on a scale of 1 to 5, indicating whether the student is qualified in the exam’s subject and recommended to receive college credit or advanced placement.

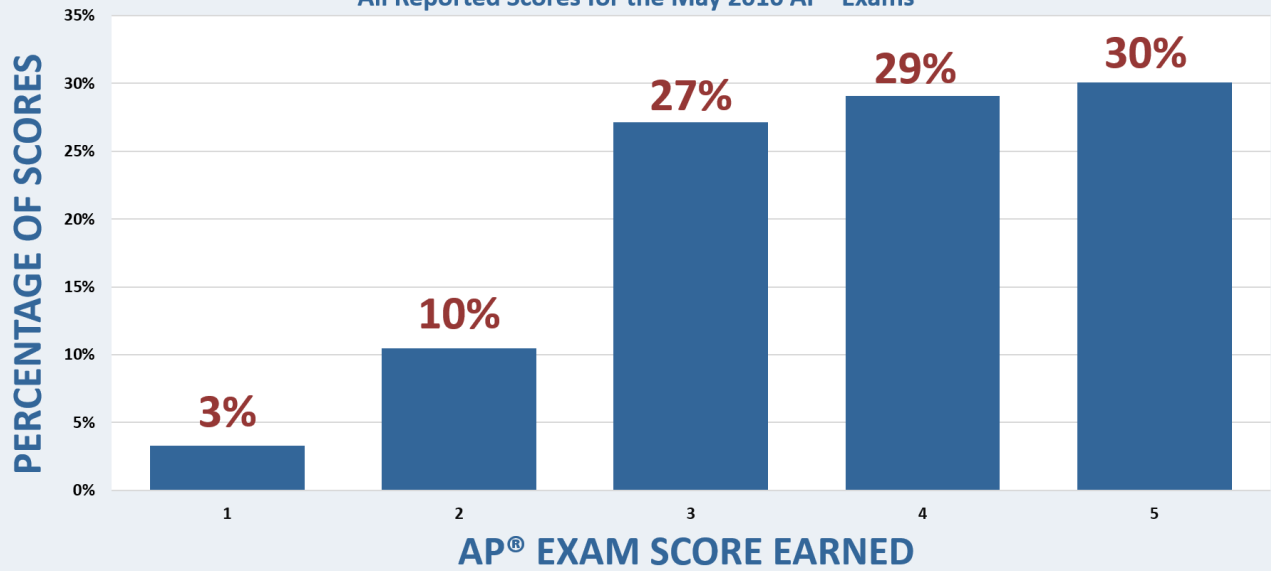

Overall HSLDA Online Academy Score Distribution

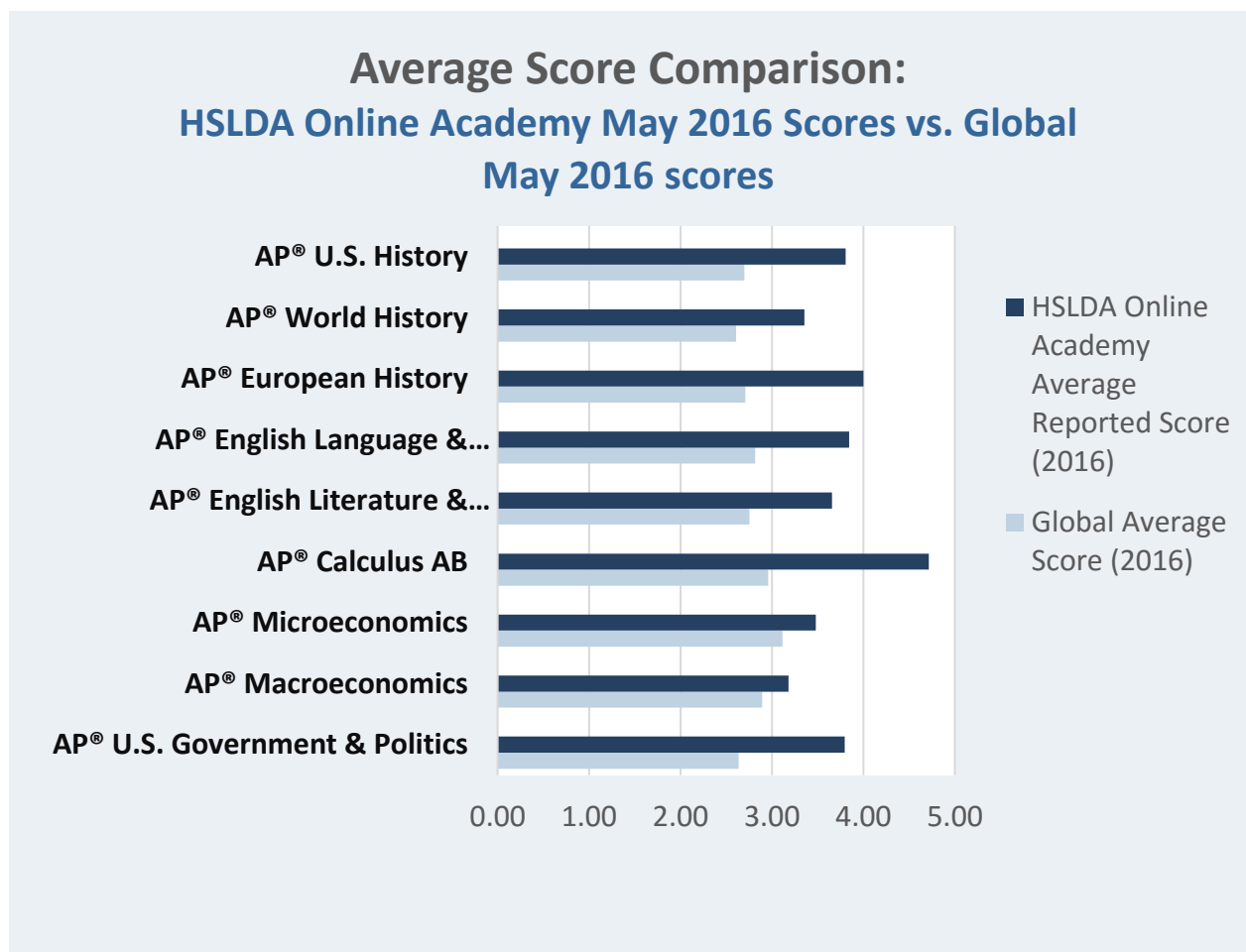
All Reported Scores for the May 2016 AP® Exams
