SYNOPSIS: Michael Farris' DVD series and book provide an overview of Constitutional Law and our nation's most important founding documents. Farris explains that, "If our government no longer faithfully adheres to the Constitution, ultimately the problem is that we are not doing our part as enlightened citizens; and when we find that the government's current actions are out of step with the Constitution, it is our duty as citizens to act."
