Synopsis: This book on Spanish conversation is an invaluable resource for advanced students. With grammar reviews, conversational strategies, and vocabulary, it will help students take the next step toward fluency.

Synopsis: This reading gives students an introduction to the world's first modern novel, *Don Quijote*, and its author, Miguel de Cervantes Saavedra—arguably the greatest writer in the Spanish language and one of the great authors in Western literature. Told in graphic novel fashion, this version gives students access to the story while still posing a challenge and new vocabulary, and paves the way for students to eventually read the original text.
