SUGGESTED WEEKLY SCHEDULE

To use this suggested chart, imagine a fifth column for your Live Class Day. This column can be inserted into the schedule wherever the live class falls on your individual calendar. For example: if your live class meets on Mondays, Live Class Day would be scheduled before Day 1. If your live class meets on Wednesdays, Live Class Day would be scheduled between Day 2 and Day 3. And so forth. Every Academy course is designed so the live class can occur on any day of the week.
