About the AP Exam Results Report

Advanced placement exams are scored on a scale of 1 to 5, indicating whether the student is qualified in the exam’s subject and recommended to receive college credit or advanced placement.

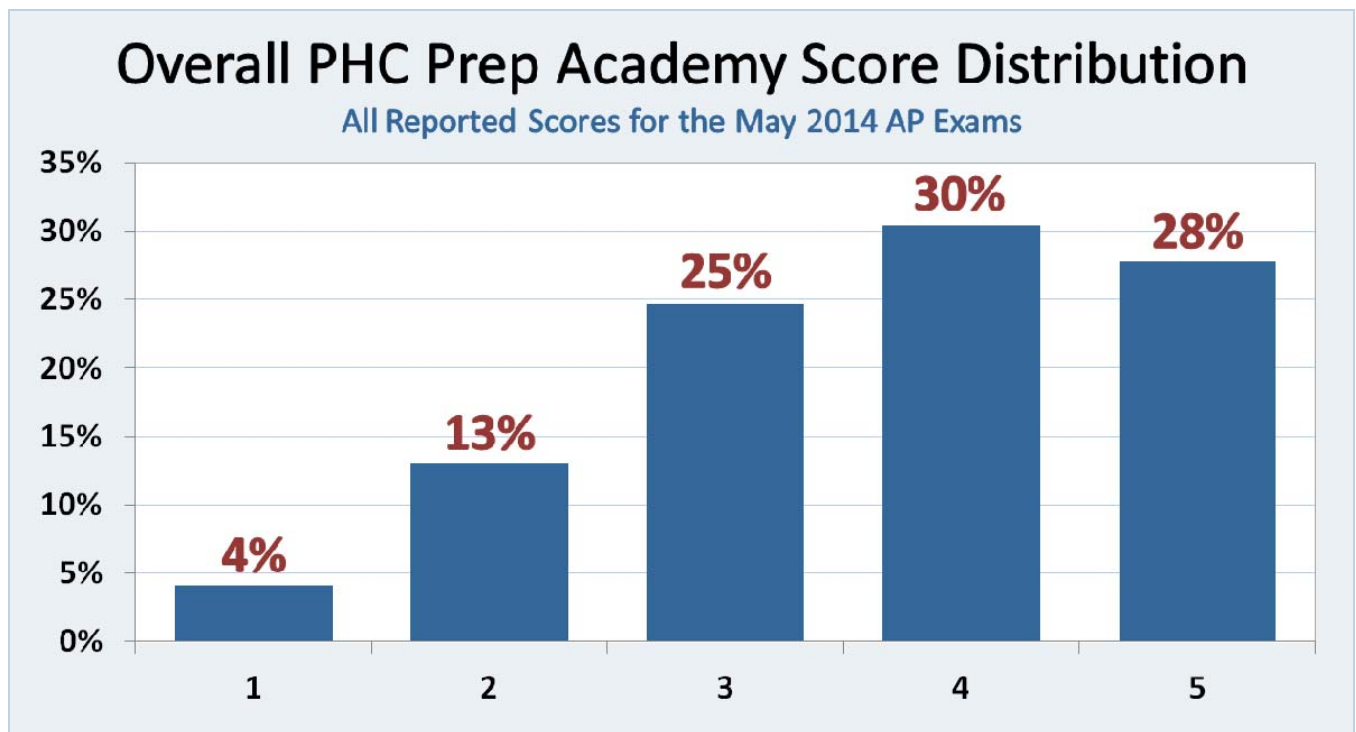

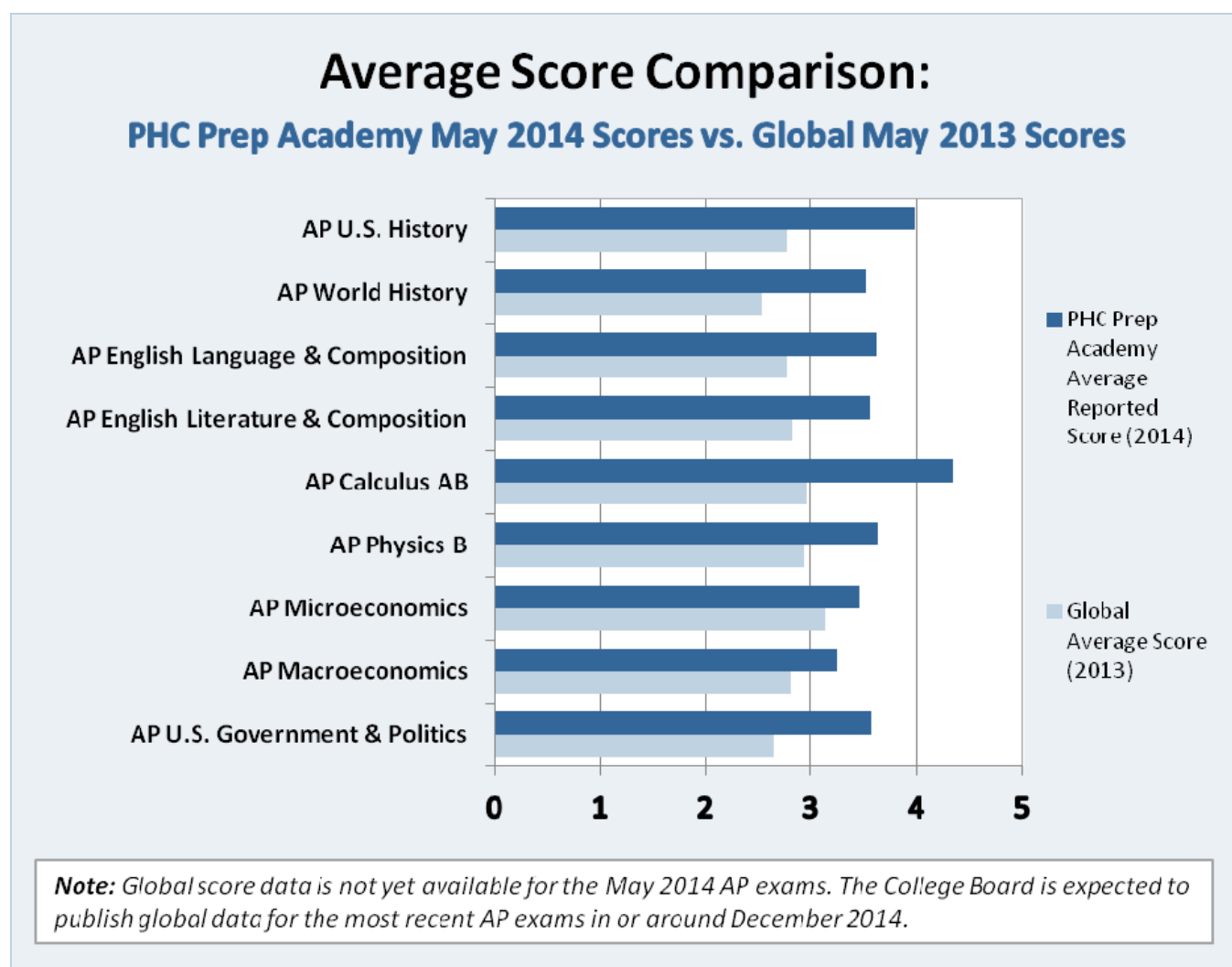


Comparison to Global AP Exam Results
